We certify that our "MARC AUREL" branded tableware items (stemware, tumblers, decanters, stoppers, etc.) are first choice and are suitable for use in contact with beverages and foodstuffs in conformity with the regulations in force.

Our glassware fulfils the regulation ISO 6486/1.2 (1999): Ceramic ware, glass-ceramic and glass dinnerware in contact with food – release of lead and cadmium.

It is formulated and produced with raw materials chemically and physically checked before production.

Main components are siliceous sand, soda, and lime stone.

The chemical composition of oxides in percentage is as follows:



CaO+MgO	%	5 - 7
Na ₂ O	%	9 - 12
K ₂ O+BaO	%	10 - 12
